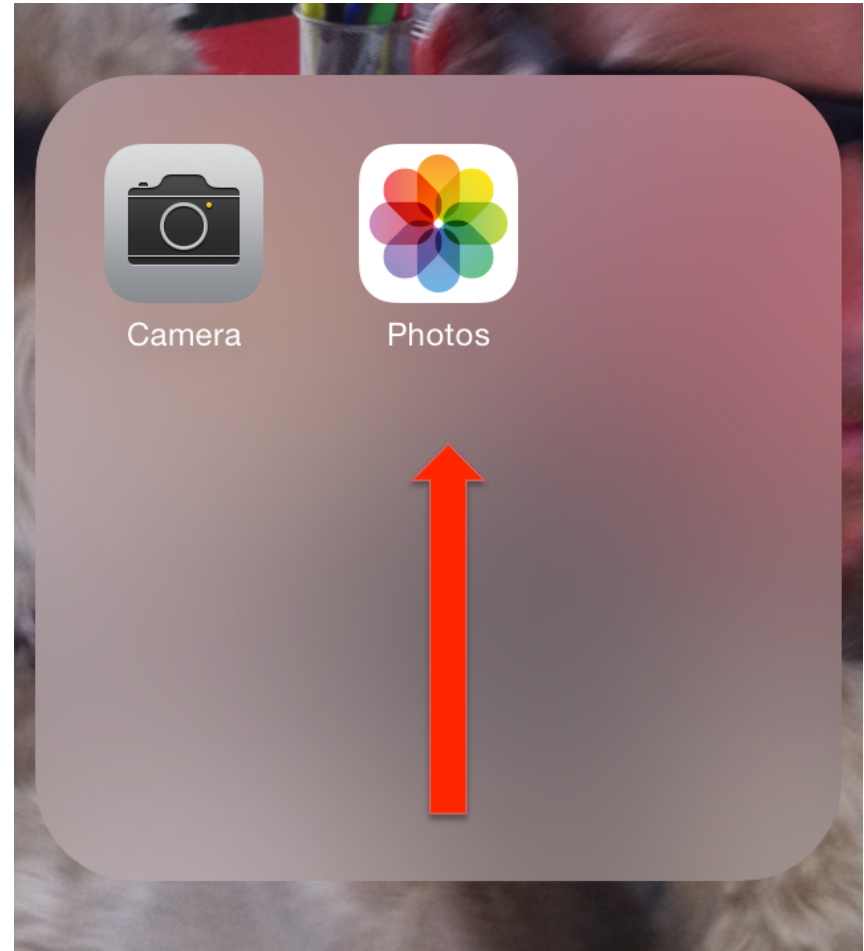
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Deleting a Photograph

If you take 1000's of pictures just to get a few “keepers,” you'll need to delete many many photos!

1. Touch the “Photos” icon – this will take you to all of your photos.



Deleting a Photograph



1. Touch the photo you want to delete.
2. Now touch the “trash can” icon.

Editing a Photo



1. Touch the photo you want to edit.
2. Now touch “Edit”.

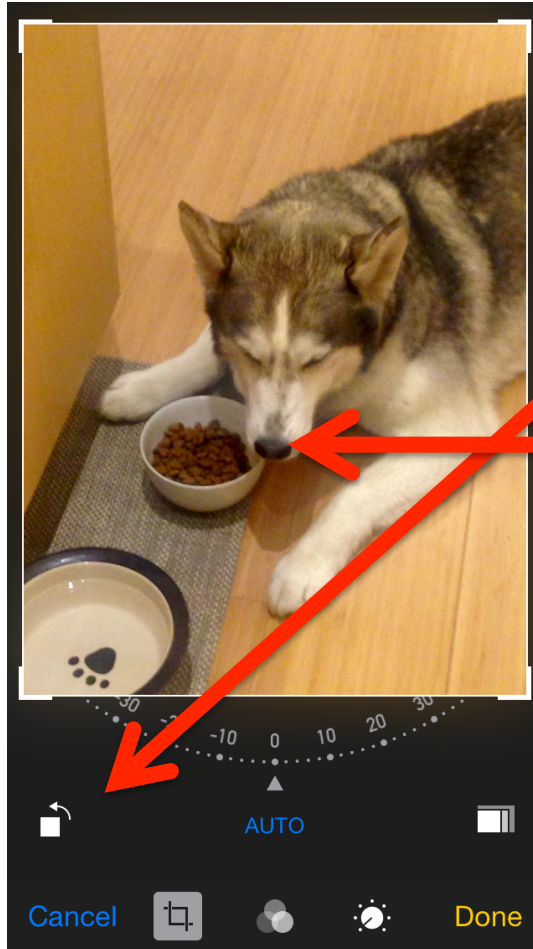
Cropping a Photo

1. Touch the “crop” icon.



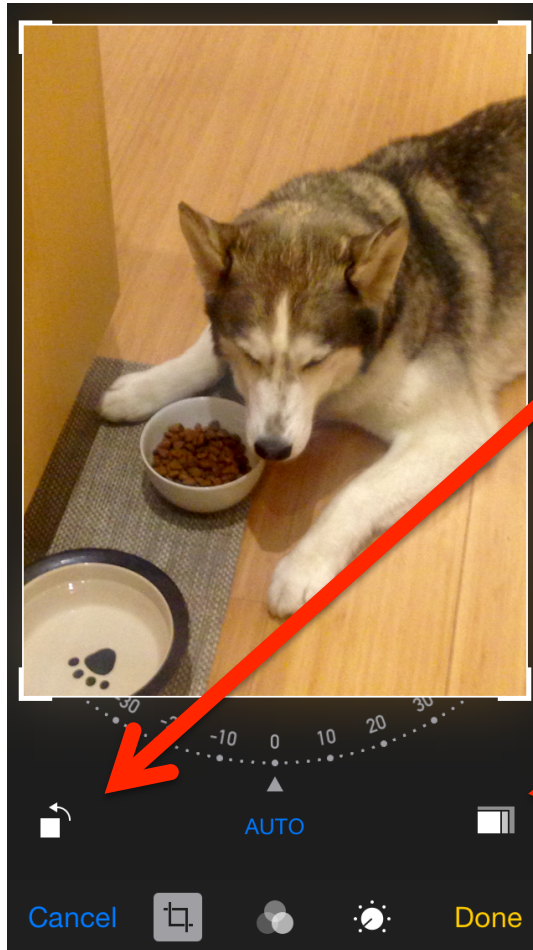
Crop Icon

Cropping a Photo



1. Touch here to “rotate” the photo. Repeat to keep rotating.
2. Touch the photo with 2 fingers and pull outward/inward to increase/decrease the size of the focus.

Cropping a Photo



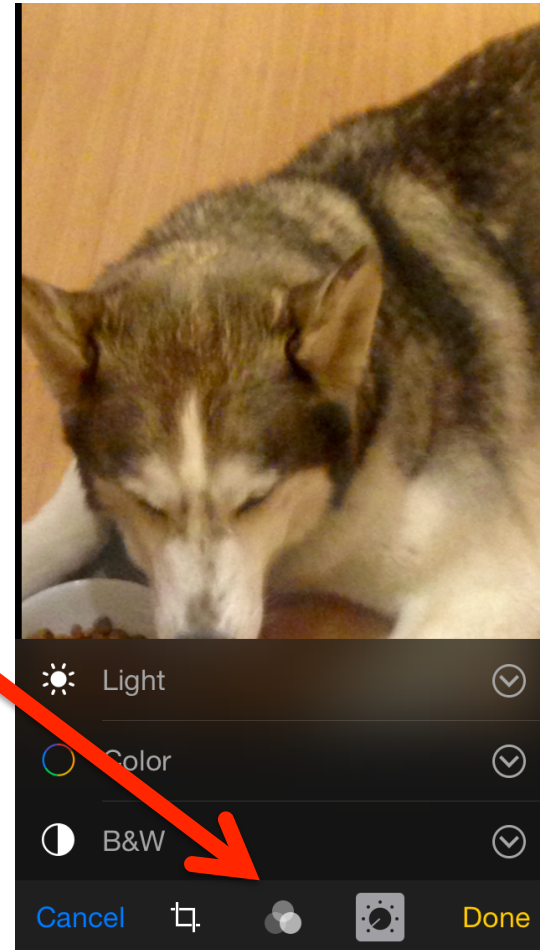
1. To move the subject of the photo, touch the photo.

The 3 X 3 grid will appear. Now move it around with your finger.

1. Touch here to “resize” the photo.

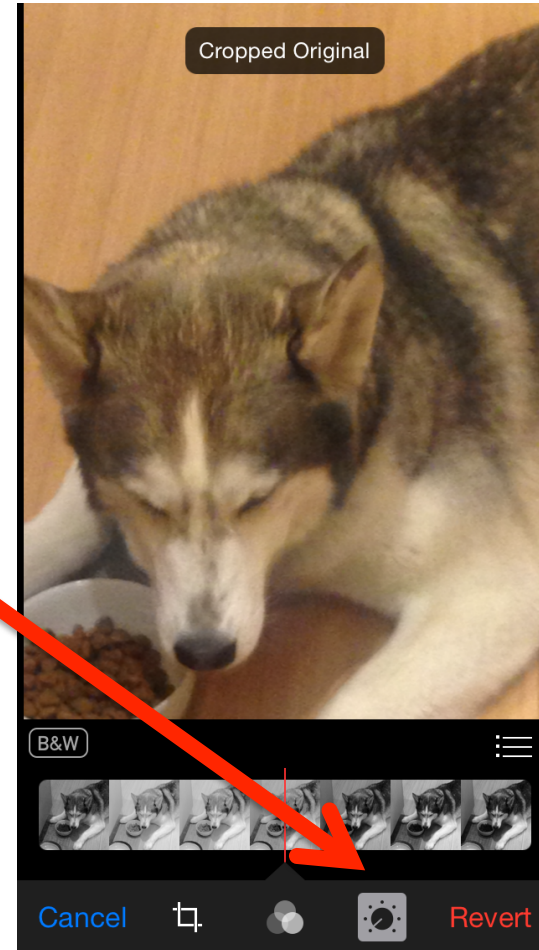
Filters

- Touch here to open the filters.
- Touch each of the options at the bottom of the screen to see the effects.



Color Adjustments

- Touch here to adjust the color.
- Adjust light
- Adjust color
- Adjust black & white
